#### ACCREDITATION

UHV is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award bachelor's and master's degrees. The UHV School of Business Administration is accredited by AACSB International - The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. The UHV School of Nursing is accredited by the Commission for Collegiate Nursing Education. The Texas Education Agency and the Council for Accreditation of Counseling & Related Educational Programs accredit the UHV School of Education & Human Development.

#### CONVENIENT COURSE DELIVERY

Face-to-face courses are offered in Victoria, Sugar Land and Katy, while online programs allow students to receive the same quality instruction from anywhere in the world.

#### TRANSFER PARTNERSHIPS

UHV welcomes students transferring from all accredited community colleges and universities, including Houston Community College, Lone Star College, Victoria College and Wharton County Junior College.

#### DEGREE IN THREE

UHV offers the Degree in Three to help freshmen in select programs earn a bachelor's degree in three years. The Dn3 was the first such program offered by a Texas public university and one of just a few in the nation.

#### ATHLETICS

The UHV Jaguars baseball and softball teams began competing in the 2007-08 season as members of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics. Golf and soccer were added in the fall of 2010 for both men and women.

#### AMERICAN BOOK REVIEW

UHV became home of the editorial offices for the American Book Review in 2006. Featuring nationally recognized writers on extended visits to the Victoria campus, the UHV/ABR Reading Series also was created in a partnership between ABR and the UHV School of Arts & Sciences.

#### STUDY ABROAD

As a way of helping students prepare to compete in a globally interdependent society, UHV offers study abroad opportunities in Mexico, London, Taiwan and Spain, with future programs planned for other countries.

#### NETWORK TECHNOLOGY

UHV offers state-of-the-art Internet connectivity from Victoria to ensure fast and reliable access for students in Victoria, Sugar Land, Cinco Ranch and around the world. As a member of the Lonestar Education and Research Network, UHV provides bandwidth to not only its own users, but also to local partners in Victoria, including Victoria College and the Region III Education Service Center and its 40-plus school districts.

#### LIBRARY

UHV shares a library with Victoria College that offers more than 250,000 items in its collection. Electronic resources feature access to more than 75 research databases and 45,000 eBooks. The library also serves students off campus with a wide variety of Web-based services.

#### SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Skilled business advisers at the SBDC offer one-stop business management assistance to small businesses and aspiring entrepreneurs in the 11-county Victoria region. Most services are free.

#### ACADEMIC CENTER

The Academic Center provides writing assistance, subject-area tutoring, testing services and instructional resources for academic and professional writing to UHV students, faculty and staff.

#### CAREER SERVICES

Serving as a link between students and employers, Career Services offers career fairs, professional development workshops and online job search resources. Career Services manages a student employment center to help students locate job possibilities both on and off campus.
