10/02/07	UHV	<b>Theft</b> – Employee’s checkbook and wallet were stolen from purse from an office in the West Bldg.
10/03/07	UHV	<b>Injury</b> – Employee slipped on floor in the hallway of the West Bldg, bruising right hand and left ankle, knee and thigh.
10/10/07	UHV	<b>Fire Alarm</b> – Employee over heated food in microwave in student lounge in West Bldg. When microwave door was opened to remove food, smoke came out and set off the fire alarm. West Bldg. was evacuated.
10/10/07	UHV	<b>Fire Alarm Malfunction</b> – The fire alarm panel call-out relay failed causing the system not to notify the monitoring service which resulted in not notifying the Victoria Fire Department.
10/16/07	UHV	<b>Theft</b> – Office cell phone stolen from Enterprise rental vehicle. Phone service has disconnected.
