

Nursing Waiver Request For Resident Tuition

Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 21 – Student Services, Subchapter B, Rule 21.29 (9) Program for Registered Nurses in Postgraduate Nursing Degree Programs.

An institution may permit a registered nurse authorized to practice professional nursing in Texas to pay resident tuition and fees without regard to the length of time that the registered nurse has resided in Texas, if the nurse:

- (A) is enrolled in a program designed to lead to a master's degree or other higher degree in nursing; and
- (B) intends to teach in a program in Texas designed to prepare students for licensure as registered nurses.

You must request the waiver before census date (12th class day/Spring or Fall, or 4th class day/Summer term) for each term you enroll to receive tuition waiver. Waivers will not be granted for prior terms. Waivers will not be submitted to the bursar office unless current RN Licensure documentation is submitted.
