The University of Houston-Victoria administers a wide range of scholarships, grants, loans and work-study programs to help pay for the costs of achieving your dreams through education.

Where to start

First, you'll need to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the optional UHV Scholarship Application as soon as possible, since money is often awarded in the order completed applications are received.

Applications can be found online at www.fafsa.gov and www.uhv.edu/ofa, or at the UHV Financial Aid Office, the University of Houston System at Sugar Land or UHS-Cinco Ranch. The UHV School code is **013231**.

You'll need to fill out new forms every year because regulations and requirements change regularly.

Remember, in order for your application to be given a high priority, it must be received by these deadlines for the following semesters:

- October 15 – Spring
- March 15 – Summer
- April 15 – Fall

Minimum Requirements

To be eligible for financial aid you must be:

- A U.S. citizen, national or permanent resident.
- Unconditionally admitted to UHV.
- Seeking a degree.
- Making satisfactory academic progress toward a degree or certification.
- Not in default on any educational loans or in debt for refunds on a federal or state grant.
- Registered with Selective Service, if male.
- Not convicted of possessing and/or selling illegal drugs while receiving federal student aid.

Different financial aid programs may have additional requirements, such as financial need and academic achievement.

If your enrollment status changes from full time to part time, your aid awarded will be adjusted accordingly.

If you are co-enrolled at UHV and Austin Community College, Coastal Bend College, Houston Community College, Victoria College or Wharton County Junior College, be sure to ask about completing a consortium agreement.

Checking your financial aid status

You will receive updates about your financial aid application status through your UHV student e-mail account, so be sure to check it regularly. Click on the links in the e-mails to go to the MyUHV Self-Service Web site, and follow the instructions listed there.

You may be required to fill out additional forms and/or submit additional information and documentation. Be sure to do everything on your "To Do" list, or your financial aid might be delayed or denied.

Receiving your aid

When you are approved for financial aid, you will receive an e-mail notifying you that you need to accept or decline an award through the MyUHV Web site.

Awards will be applied first to any outstanding balance you have with UHV for tuition or fees. The remainder will be disbursed according to the preference you indicated when you activated your Jaguar Card.

A few points to remember

- If you are receiving a student loan for the first time at UHV, you will likely have to complete a Master Promissory Note and will be required to take the online Direct Loan Entrance Counseling course at the Direct Loan website: <https://studentloans.gov>.
- Financial aid eligibility is re-evaluated between the first and 12th class day to make any needed adjustments for changes in your enrollment status, class load, academic progress or other criteria.


Funds will be distributed at the earliest on the first day of classes, so please make your financial plans accordingly.

Jaguar Card

Along with serving as your UHV library card, the Jaguar Card you should have received in the mail provides a convenient way to receive disbursements. After activating the card at JaguarCard.com, you can select your preferred way to receive your money:

- EasyRefund to the OneAccount linked to your card
- Direct deposit into a bank account of your choice
- Paper check

You can use your Jaguar Card to access money in your OneAccount by using it as a debit card or by accessing an ATM like the one on the first floor of the University Center next to the vending machines.
