Projects of this type are:

1. Visiting nursing homes and reading books, bringing flowers, playing bingo games, and singing.
2. Providing magazines for hospitals, books for prisons, and books for libraries.
3. Manning phones for "child abuse" or "crises" lines.
4. Visiting VA hospitals, manning Salvation Army booths, Christmas caroling.
5. Helping the humane society; donating to museums.
6. Helping with disaster aid; holding bike-a-thon for charity.
7. Conducting blood pressure checks and participating in blood drives.
8. Working with underprivileged children (Easter Egg hunts, Christmas parties, and trips)
9. Community beautification programs; recycling newspapers and aluminum cans.
10. Helping low-income persons plant gardens.
11. Working with Boy Scout, Girl Scout, Campfire, Big Brother/Big Sister, and similar programs.
