Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and a parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this institutional verification document, attach any required documents, and submit them to us. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

To obtain a **2020 IRS Tax Return Transcript**, go to www.irs.gov and click "Get Your Tax Record." Next, select "Get Transcript by MAIL or ONLINE". Other options to request a tax return transcript include calling the IRS at 1-800-908-9946 or completing a Paper Request Form – IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript."
